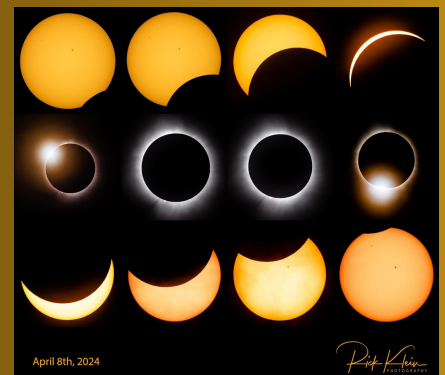


Sisters in the Sun for the Solar Eclipse!
